## F & J Employment Regulations

## **On-Campus Employment**

- F-1 and J-1 students can work no more than 20 hours per week on campus while school is in session.
- During the summer break, students may work full time on campus.
- J-1 students are required to let the ISS know if they get an on-campus job as on-campus employment approval is required and information about that on-campus job must be placed in the Student and Exchange Visitor system.
- On campus employment does not have to be related to a student's degree.
- F-2 students/dependents cannot work on or off campus.
- J-2 students must apply for an Employment Authorization Document from USCIS to obtain on-campus or off campus employment authorization.
- If you do not have an SSN number and get an on-campus job, F-1 and J-1 students will need to complete our SSN Verification form. **This form is only for on-campus employment.**

### **Off-Campus Employment**

- Both F-1 and J-1 students must have prior approval and authorization in order to work off campus.
- Working off campus without authorization carries serious immigration consequences.
- Having a social security number does not mean that you have approval to work off campus. F-1 and J-1 students must meet the eligibility requirements and receive prior approval and written authorization for off-campus work/training.
- In the case of CPT for F-1 students and Academic Training for J-1 students, the training must be directly related to your degree and integral to your curriculum. Enrollment in an internship course is required.

## **Undergraduate Fee Update**

Beginning with the Winter 2024 Term, international undergraduate students will be assessed a quarterly fee of \$150, which will be automatically charged to their student accounts. The fee enables us to offer various services to our international undergraduate students, such as helping them with student visas, advising them on international student issues, assisting them to adapt to academic life at UC Riverside, and complying with federal laws. The fee also covers the expenses of dealing with the growing and complicated government rules and reporting obligations and improves the quality of service for the international UC RIVERSIDE International Affairs

Happy Diwali Highlanders!


We are excited for you to join us for our FIRST-EVER Diwali Event hosted by ISS!
