## Immigration Reminders F and J students

Did your address recently change? Update your address and phone number with our office by completing our <u>document request form</u> and in R'web.

- All F and J students are required to report any change in their physical address within 10 days.
- When entering your address in R'web:
  - **U.S. Address (physical address):** (Do not include any dashes/hyphens, street address and apartment number should be on line one)

- All **F-1 and J-students** must enroll in full-time units (12 units) each quarter per federal regulations. Please ensure that you are registered full-time for the Winter quarter.
  - Students can drop below 12 units in very limited circumstances with advanced approval from an international student advisor in the ISS office.
  - F and J students can only take one online course to count towards their full-time enrollment of 12 units.
  - Please remember that academic advisors/graduate student services advisors are not your international student advisor. Academic advisors and graduate student services advisors cannot provide F and J students with permission to drop below 12 units.

If you have decided to take a quarter off or cancel your enrollment for any reason, it is your responsibility to directly notify an international student advisor in the ISS office. Plan ahead and speak with an ISS international student advisor before dropping below 12 units or before taking a break from school during the Fall, Winter, or Spring quarters.

- Enrolling in less than 12 units or taking a break from courses during the academic year without advanced permission may impact your ability to maintain status and remain in the United States.
- **F-2 students** cannot enroll in full time units. F-2 students must enroll in less than 12 units.
- **F-1 and J-1 Graduate and Undergraduate students** in their final quarter, must submit a <u>Reduced Course Load Form</u> to our office.

#### Undergraduate Students Only (F and J)

If this is your last quarter and you will be below 12 units or if you are an F-2 student and will be taking 10 units or less, you must submit a Reduced Course Load Form to our office by 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 17. This will give us time to initiate a reduced tuition fee request on your behalf in My Forms. This request will then be routed to the Registrars' office. The Registrar's office has a strict deadline for these forms and will not accept any late forms. Please review the <u>academic calendar</u> for important dates and deadlines.

# **OPT FEE**

## **OPT Processing Fee starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024**

Starting January 1, 2024, students who apply for OPT or the STEM OPT Extension will need to pay a processing fee of \$100 for the regular 12-month OPT and \$300 for the STEM OPT Extension. This fee adjustment is essential to sustain and enhance the quality of our immigration services in light of Department of Homeland Security's ever-increasing demands and reporting requirements. In addition, they help ISS provide necessary immigration support to students during their OPT and STEM OPT Extension periods.

Students should submit their request forms to ISS first, at which time ISS will determine if they are eligible to apply for OPT or the STEM OPT Extension. Then, students will receive a link to pay the fee online by credit card. Once the payment receipt is forwarded to ISS, the OPT I-20 or the STEM OPT Extension I-20 can be issued. Please note that these I-20s cannot be issued before ISS receives the payment receipt. The OPT and the STEM OPT Extension fees are <u>non-refundable</u>, so make sure you are eligible to apply <u>before</u> paying the fee.

# **USCIS PROCESSING FEES**

#### USCIS | Premium Processing Fees to Increase February 26, 2024

In December 2023 a rule was published by USCIS that will increase Premium Processing fees for requests postmarked on or after February 26, 2024. The new USCIS Premium Processing Fees will increase for the following forms:

Form Type	Current Fee	New Fee (2/26/2024)
I-129	\$2,500	\$2,805
I-140	\$2,500	\$2,805
I-539	\$1,750	\$1,965
I-765	\$1,500	\$1,685

USCIS has noted that any I-907 (Request for Premium Processing) received on or after February 26, 2024 will be rejected and the submitted filing fee returned. The <u>USCIS</u> <u>News Release</u> contains additional details and rationale for the increases.
